



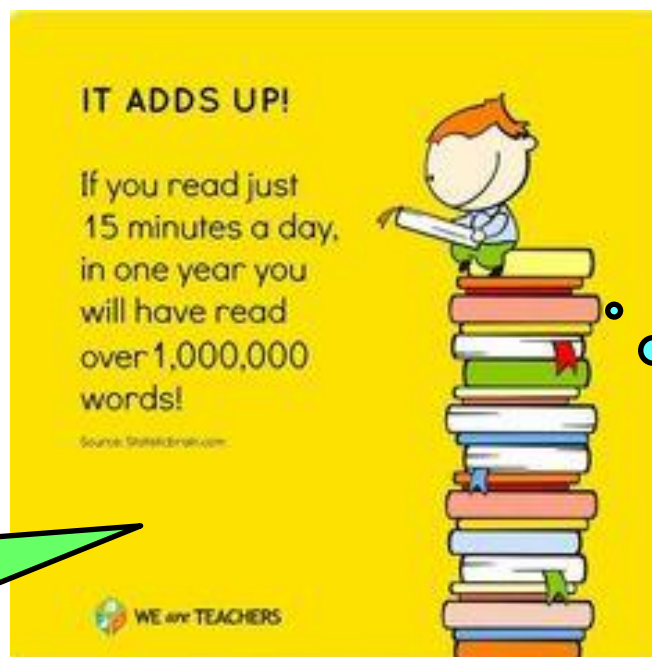
We really value reading here at Cardinal Heenan and we want you to become a confident and eager reader too.

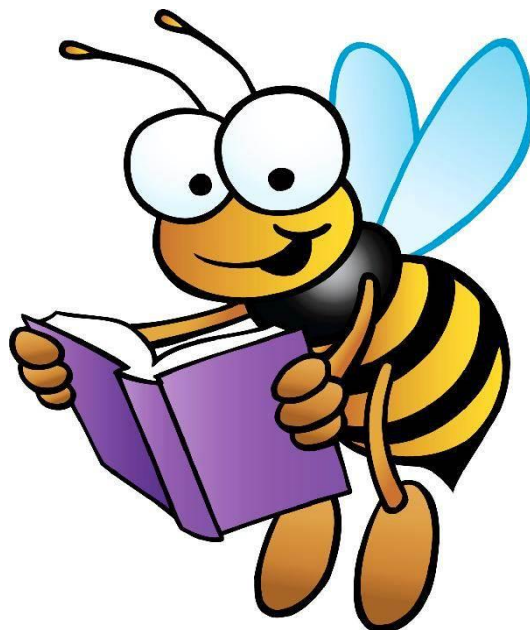
Reflection: Write down some thoughts on what you have read so far. Answer in full sentences.

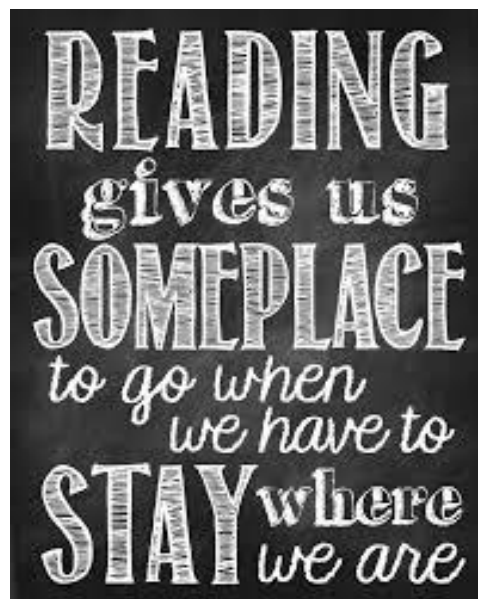

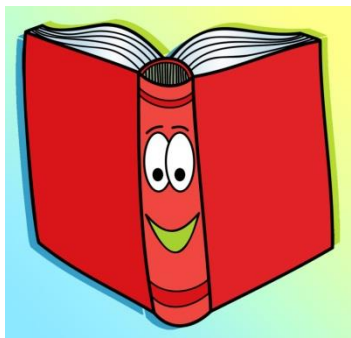
