Approximately 20% of the UK workforce is employed in science-based careers. A total of 5.8 million people. The average Chemist salary in Liverpool is £28,893 annually, ranging from £22,500 to £35,000. In 2022 there have been over 300 job postings for Chemical Scientists in East Merseyside, with an average wage of £33,000 per year.
