Dear Parents

Further to my letter of 22nd January, I write to give you the latest information on the forthcoming **A level 2021** programme. Despite the frustrating uncertainty, which still surrounds this year's arrangements, there are things that Year 12 and 13 students can do to secure the best possible grades.

Please encourage your son to remain focussed. More so now than ever, he is in charge of his future. The school will do all it can to supplement his learning but he must also develop and hone the skills required for individual learning. Online work, research, a disciplined and organised approach to his tasks, and most importantly maintaining communication with his teachers and having full attendance for his online lessons so that he can readily avail himself of assistance and encouragement. Remember, 'none of us is as smart as all of us' (K Blanchard). As soon as the government allow schools to re-open, we will be at the vanguard in welcoming your son back.

In order to maintain good communication between the school and you as our parents and carers, we will be moving to a remote virtual video call system in order to conduct our forthcoming parents' evening on Tuesday, 2nd February 2021. We will be using a system called 'School Cloud', which is an education based software for holding such events. We are aware that this system has worked well in other educational settings, so we are hopeful it will provide a suitable alternative to meeting in person.

At the appropriate time, you will need to log on to book your teacher appointments via the site <https://cardinalheenanl12.schoolcloud.co.uk/>. To login, you simply input some basic details about yourself and your child, including Student's First name, Surname, Form class, Date of Birth, Login Code. This needs to be the same information as we hold for you in school. You can also watch the video in the following link to support you <https://vimeo.com/473882995>.

The booking system for this event will available from 27th January 2021 and will be open until 1:00pm Tuesday, 2nd February 2021. We advise that you visit the website before the appointments open to ensure you are familiar with the system, and that your information matches that which we hold in school. Having logged onto the system, you will have the facility to select appointments for each of the subjects your child studies. It is important to set your availability in terms of time so as to be able to book appointments with all the teachers you wish to meet. Appointments will last 5 minutes. Please note that as this is an automated system, your 5-minute session will automatically end when the 5-minute time slot has elapsed. You can use a phone/tablet/computer to 'attend' the parents' evening, as long as it has at least a microphone and a camera, if you wish to share that too.

Once a teacher's appointment slots are filled for the evening, they will not be able to accommodate any extra appointments; therefore, it is important that you log on at the earliest possibility in order to ensure that you get the slot you want. These appointments are the perfect opportunity for discussing your son's progress. **Although the government have said that, the grades, which will be generated, are teacher grades, students need to be mindful that the final grades given in the summer will be the result of the work being marked, standardised and moderated**



by other schools. This is a centre process, which we followed last year, and we will be doing the same again this year. Thus at the parents' evening, teachers will not be able to give final forecast grades.

In the meantime, as parents you can prompt your son to plan for the future. There will be new dawn and so he should be enquiring about apprenticeships, further education, especially in applying for university places. The Unifrog destinations platform is an excellent place to start. Ms McCabe will also be available to advise on these matters.

We are in a time of change, but it is just a moment in time. Don't allow your son to give up or become despondent. Tell him that he must think like a proton. Always positive. As Barack Obama said, "The future rewards those who press on. I don't have time to feel sorry for myself. I don't have time to complain. I'm going to press on".

I send my best wishes and pray that you will stay safe and well.

Step 1: Login

Step 4: Choose Teachers

If you chose the automatic booking mode, drag the sliders at the top of the screen to indicate the earliest and latest you can attend.

Select the teachers you'd like to book appointments with. A green tick indicates they're selected. To de-select, click on their name.

You may book other teachers not listed on the screen by clicking *Add a Teacher*.

Step 5a (Automatic): Book Appointments

If you chose the automatic booking mode, you'll see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose Accept at the bottom left.

If it wasn't possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again, or switch to manual booking mode (Step 5b).

Step 5b (Manual): Book Appointments
