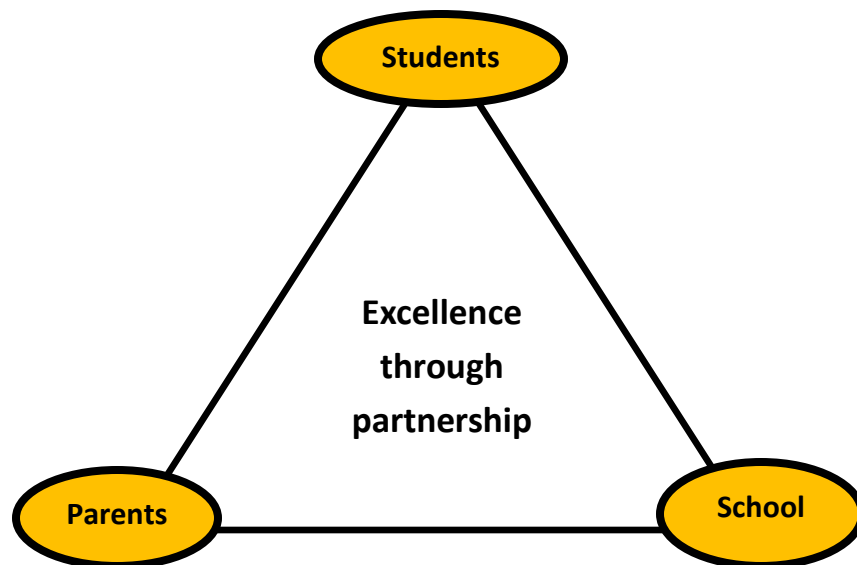
Mission Statement

- Respect:** In any verbal or written communication with the school, mutual respect and civility will be expected

- Achieve:** Guarantee that the student attends school every day and is punctual
- Achieve:** Guarantee that the student attends school in full school uniform, with planner, bag and correct equipment (pen, pencil, ruler, calculator, PE kit)
- Achieve:** Contact the school when appropriate; work closely with the school in the interest of the student and other members of the school community.
