
Mission Statement

HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The school will aim to:

- provide a safe, happy and caring environment which reflects the Catholic ethos of the school through consistent application of the school rules
- treat all students with fairness and consistency; offering support, guidance and care
- develop the full potential of all students spiritually, morally, culturally and socially
- provide a curriculum that not only meets the statutory requirements but also considers the individual needs
 of the student, ensuring lessons are appropriately engaging and challenging so that all students make as much
 progress as possible
- build effective relationships which promote good behaviour and a sense of responsibility and belonging across the school community
- take pride in and celebrate all students' efforts and achievements, encouraging all to aim high
- communicate with parents/guardians and keep them informed of their child's progress
- let parents/guardians know of any concerns or problems that affect their child's progress or behaviour
- offer opportunities for parents/guardians to become involved in the daily life of the school

The parent/guardian will:

- ensure that the student attends school regularly, arrives no later than 8.20am, and understands that the **minimum** target for attendance is **97%**
- guarantee that the student attends school in full school uniform including the <u>compulsory</u> school coat, with a bag and correct equipment (pen, pencil, ruler, glue, highlighter, scientific calculator and PE kit)
- support the school rules outlined in the behaviour policy which have been set for the benefit of all students
 including adhering to our mobile phone policy
- show respect and civility in any verbal or written communication with the school
- inform the school of any concerns which may affect the progress or behaviour of their child
- encourage the student to be ambitious and to work as hard as they can both in school and at home
- attend all parents' evenings/meetings/events or contact the school for alternative appointments
- encourage the student to get involved in the wider life of the school

The student will:

- attend school regularly, arrive no later than 8.20am, understands that the **minimum** target for attendance is **97%** and will be punctual for all lessons
- attend school in full school uniform including the <u>compulsory</u> school coat, with a bag and correct equipment (pen, pencil, ruler, glue, highlighter, scientific calculator and PE kit)
- value and respect all members of the school and wider community. Behave sensibly and safely at all times
- follow the school rules outlined in the behaviour policy which have been set for the benefit of all including adhering to our mobile phone policy
- behave in a way that shows they value the school, its premises, buildings, furniture and equipment
- be ambitious; work hard and take pride in everything they do
- contribute to the wider life of the school and uphold its values so they fully utilise their God-given talents
