Year 7 – 9 Assessments

Your son's end of year assessments will take place between: Monday 24th June – Thursday 27th June 2023.

This is an ideal opportunity for your son to display the progress that he has made this school year. He will be provided with revision materials in each subject and an assessment timetable which I have attached for you to keep at home. Assessments will take place in classrooms for years 7 – 9. Pupils must bring in their revision materials as they will have an opportunity to revise in the lesson prior to each assessment each day.

Pupils will take 2 assessments per day as scheduled in period 3 and period 5. As a result, in order to accommodate an hour assessment in the last lesson then this will mean that years 7, 8 and year 9 will finish slightly later than normal. Some subjects will conduct their assessments in their usual lesson time – these are mentioned on the attached timetable.

It is extremely important that your son attends every assessment. Attendance is a whole school priority and every student has a target of 97% attendance. We expect all pupils to attend all week and I hope we can count on your support. Every day really does count for our school and your child.

I would be grateful if you could encourage your son to revise for these assessments at home and also to ensure that he brings the revision materials into school during assessments. He should also be fully equipped for each assessment. He needs a pen, pencil, ruler and a calculator if appropriate.

Normal lessons will resume on Friday 28th June. Year 9 will have an additional Maths assessment during period 1.

Many thanks in advance for your co-operation at this important time. Hopefully by working together, your son will make the progress that his efforts warrant.
